Guiding Principles

- Ensure the rights of all individuals are respected and protected while attending our camp
- Establish the most safe and best possible learning environment for all camp participants
- Ensure that breaches of the Code of Conduct are treated in a manner fair and consistent for all

Expectations

- Parents should bring matters of concern to camp operators or the camp director
- Parents should avoid correcting or disciplining campers who are not their children
- Parents and campers have the responsibility to behave according to this code of conduct
- Parents and campers have the responsibility to treat each other and all property with respect
- Parents and campers will not threaten, intimidate, harass, bully, or interfere with the participation of others
- Campers have the responsibility to follow instructions given by camp operators and staff

Rules – the following forms of behavior are considered a violation of this conduct policy, are unacceptable, and may result in dismissal of the camper for the day or for duration of camp, strictly at the discretion of camp operators:

- Camp COVID protocols are in place for our collective safety and must always be followed
- Tobacco products and vaping devices, alcohol, non-prescribed drugs, weapons, and sexual material **MUST NOT** be brought to camp under any circumstances
- Cell phones use is for emergencies and is restricted to breaks periods and other non-instructional times
- Using offensive, harassing, sexist, racist, or insulting language is not allowed
- Fighting, bullying, or all other forms of aggressive behavior is prohibited
- Leaving camp boundaries without permission is prohibited
- Interfering with the public's use of Hutchins Park must be avoided
- Behaving in a manner potentially dangerous to self and others is prohibited
- Damaging, misusing, or vandalizing camp, Hutchins Park, or camp adjacent property is prohibited

Any breach of the Rules or the Code of Conduct will initiate a disciplinary action. HdG Youth Sailing Program reserves the right to suspend or dismiss a camper from participation in camp activities, without refund of camp fees, if such discipline is deemed required. Before such discipline is finalized, the camper and camper's parent/guardian will meet with camp operators and the camp director to determine the best course of action.
